WELCOME

Welcome to this year's LMA model airshow - we hope that you enjoy the weekend!

To make sure everybody has an enjoyable and safe weekend this sheet has some important information, so PLEASE ENSURE ALL MEMBERS OF YOUR PARTY READ THIS INFORMATION.

BEHAVIOUR ON SITE

We are using this site by kind permission of the RAF, and to protect our continued use of the venue, anybody displaying anti-social behaviour or deemed to be acting in a manner which would preclude us from using the site next year will be asked to leave. YOU WILL BE EVICTED WITHOUT ANY FORM OF REFUND OR RE-ENTRY NEXT YEAR.

DOGS

DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD AND UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES. PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PETS.

SCOOTERS / THREE—FOUR WHEELER BIKES / GOPEDS / MINI MOTORBIKES

These are NOT PERMITTED within the Confines of the airfield except when arriving or departing. A HELMET MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES.

GENERATORS are permitted but must be switched off between 10:30 pm and 7:00 am,

to be considerate to the other campers on site.

CATERING is available over the weekend as well as a bar and evening

entertainment.

NIGHT FLYING is allowed for IC powered models until 19:30 and quiet electric models

until 23:00. All flying to be under the control of officials on the main display runway at a designated point only, nowhere else on the airfield.

FIRE SAFETY

- Each camping pitch should provide at least one fire extinguisher, manufactured to BS 5423 or BS EN3 and rated 13A (equivalent to a 9.1 litre water/gas expelled or similar dry powder extinguisher where gas appliances are in use).
- Where cooking facilities are being used at least one fire blanket must be provided. When gas
 rings are used to heat boilers etc., they must be stood on flameproof material which will not
 transmit heat. Cooking appliances must not be stood directly on grass. Fuel burning
 appliances must not be used inside tents or awnings.
- Barbeques or open fires may not be allowed on site. When not allowed, any barbeque or open fire will be extinguished by the fire service or security.
- When used, make sure that barbeques are kept at least 300mm above the ground and at a safe distance from caravans, awnings and tents. Do not leave hot barbeques unattended or dispose of hot ashes with general rubbish.
- When generators are used they must be situated a minimum of 3m from any tent, caravan or vehicle. Generators must be switched off before refuelling.
- Fuel must be stored in containers that comply with The Petroleum (Consolidation)
 Regulations 2014 (PCR) and all containers should be stored away from any potential sources
 of ignition and in a well ventilated location.


- In the event of a fire please evacuate everyone from the caravan or tent and raise the alarm immediately by contacting any site official or by ringing 999 from a mobile phone, please state your exact location.
- Fire-fighting equipment is provided in the camping areas; only attempt to extinguish a fire if you are competent in the use of the equipment, and it is safe to do so.
- In the event of an incident please follow the directions of show officials, and ensure that your children remain with you and that they are aware of the dangers from attending fire engines.

ACCESS TO LMA COSFORD 2018



Access for campers from 14:00 until 18:00 on Friday 6 July will be via Crash Gate 4 at the south west end of Cosford airfield. Please do not arrive before 14:00, and do not go to Cosford Museum, as there is very little parking space available.

To avoid the traffic problems we have seen in previous years, please do not drive through Albrighton, follow the route given here.

Follow the A41 from the M54 past the turnoff to Cosford, through the traffic lights and under the railway bridge. Do not turn right and go through Albrighton.

Carry on the A41 for approximately 3 miles to the next set of traffic lights.

Turn sharp right onto the A464.

Follow the A464 for approximately 3 miles until you see the 'LMA' sign just after Bowling Green Lane and turn right into the airfield entrance. Do not go down Bowling Green Lane.

The nearest satnav postcode is WV7 3BT, but please follow the instructions and map above to get there.

Access from 18:00 on Friday 6 July onwards will be via Crash Gate 2 adjacent to RAF Cosford.

Everyone must be clear of the airfield by 20:00 on Sunday 8 July. If you wish to stay overnight on the Sunday, please speak to the camping manager on arrival.
